Your cooperative also has a Safety Smart coloring book program for all second graders attending schools in Caddo Electric's service area. These coloring books teach the students all about electrical safety.

If your body or an object you are holding comes in contact with it, you become the path the unleashed energy is seeking. Since most power lines are uninsulated, touching one is like touching a lightning bolt... only worse.
